## "RESEARCH IN PROGRESS" SEMINAR

## Deadline for receipt of proposals: 21 February 2025

The Centre interuniversitaire d'études et de recherches autochtones (CIÉRA) is calling for papers for a seminar on current research as part of its 23<sup>rd</sup> annual symposium, to be held on 15 and 16 May 2025 at the Musée de la civilisation

The purpose of this seminar is to invite student members of CIÉRA to present their work in progress or at the end of the project and to receive feedback from experienced professors who are regular or associate members of CIÉRA. This mentoring activity will enable students to benefit from the expertise of researchers in the same field or in other fields related to Indigenous research. Interested students will be able to present their thesis or dissertation project, or a draft article or chapter.

Presentations may take the form of a traditional oral presentation, a video clip or an art installation. The presentation itself will last approximately 20 minutes, followed by a commentary by the mentor (10 min) and a discussion with the other participants (10 min). To ensure effective feedback, the texts will be presented to the mentors beforehand.

To take part, the student must be a member of CIÉRA and submit a paper of **no more than 300 words**. The subject must be related to CIÉRA's scientific programm. Proposals must be submitted by completing the following form: <u>FORM</u> no later than **21 February 2025** Students whose proposals are selected will be contacted by **17 March 2025**.

After selection, the full texts to be presented to the mentors must be **no more than 6,000 words** long (excluding notes and bibliography) and are due no later than **23 April 2025**.

Subject to editorial standards, the papers presented at the seminar will be published in an issue of CIÉRA's cahiers, whose main mission is to disseminate the work of the first authors. They will be peer-reviewed and published in open access (editorial instructions will be communicated to the selected students).
